WHO CAN GET THIS REQUIRED TRAINING?

This American Heart Association Pediatric First Aid/CPR instruction and certification is made available **AT NO COST** to childcare staff who ...

- ◆ Do not yet have Pediatric First Aid/CPR training, causing the facility where they work to receive citations for non-compliance;
- ◆ Have an expired Pediatric First Aid/CPR certification;
- ◆ Are newly hired and do not yet have Pediatric First Aid/CPR
- ◆ Have a Pediatric First Aid/CPR certification that will expire in one year of their facility's certificate of compliance expiration date;
- ◆ Will need Pediatric First Aid/CPR training for compliance within one year of their facility's certificate of compliance expiration date.

NOTE: Early childcare workers are not required to be PDO-sponsored students who are pursuing a CDA credential or degree program.

HOW WILL TRAINING BE OFFERED?

Childcare educators will get the best of a combined training approach! This training and certification is offered via online skill development and hands-on training/skill testing onsite at your facility or close by.
