WHO CAN GET THIS REQUIRED TRAINING?

The OCDEL-approved Pediatric First Aid/CPR instruction and certification is made available **AT NO COST** to staff who ...

- ◆ Do not yet have Pediatric First Aid/CPR training, causing the facility where they work to receive citations for non-compliance;
- ◆ Have an expired Pediatric First Aid/CPR certification;
- ◆ Are newly hired and do not yet have Pediatric First Aid/CPR;
- ◆ Have a Pediatric First Aid/CPR certification that will expire in one year of their facility's certificate of compliance expiration date;
- ◆ Will need Pediatric First Aid/CPR training for compliance within one year of their facility's certificate of compliance expiration.

NOTE: Early childhood educators who pursue Pediatric First Aid/CPR training are not required to be PDO-funded students.

HOW WILL TRAINING BE OFFERED?

You will work directly with ECEPDO-contracted trainers to find a time and training method that best meets your needs.
